

Virtual Prayer Walk- Malta Day 2

Here are your instructions for our Virtual Prayer Walking Experience today!

Background: Prayer spotlight on “E”, “J” from Malawi.

We start our prayer walking today in Marsaskala which is situated in southern Malta. I (Amos) regularly go down there to meet with two young Malawian boys. They are both Christian and I'm discipling them using Discovery Bible Study methods (which you will learn tomorrow in our virtual mission). I have already started to share some of the tools we use like 3 circles and the 15 second testimony.

We meet at one of the coffee shops in the street where we started the prayer walk.

Pray for them as they are in college here in Malta but with the corona virus they are struggling with their finances as one of them was let go from their job.

Pray for the African migrants working at shops and in the construction industry here as we walk. Many are working illegally because they don't have any documents to work in Malta or their documents only allow them to work in Italy.

The prayer walk ends in the street where these two young men live.

Pray for the relationship these two boys have with each other. The younger one is really passionate about the Lord and wants to pursue a career in football coaching. The older one is currently playing rugby for the national team and as a result, he gets injured a lot.

Go ahead and begin your prayer walking journey by clicking on the link (Link 1: [Prayer Walk One](#)) and then click VIEW MAP (toward the bottom of the page that opens). You will then be taken into the website. **Click Play Now** and **pray** as you go!

Background: Prayer spotlight on “G” from Cameroon and “S” from the Gambia.

We start our prayer walk at Eden Cinema where I meet “S” from Gambia (who is a *M) for Discovery Bible Study. **Pray** for him as he is currently away from Malta trying to secure his documents so that he can remain in Europa. **Pray** also that Jesus might come and encounter him personally.

“G” from Cameroon works at small tailor shop. He is a Christian and comes from the English side of Cameroon and asks you to **pray** for an end to the conflict in his nation. He also asks for us to **pray** for his finances here in Malta because he has to send a lot of money back to Cameroon to his family because of the persecution they face.

We end the prayer walk at Buggiba square where you will find many west African migrants hanging around in the late evening during the summer time. **Pray** that this square might be a place where they encounter Jesus.

Background: Prayer spotlight on “B” from the Gambia.

Our last prayer walk will be in the neighbouring European island of Sicily, Italy in the city of Catania. “[Search Party](#)” is an organization working in Catania with African migrants. Through them, we hear of people leaving Catania and coming to Malta for work. **Pray** for Search Party as they continue with their work in Sicily, **pray** for our relationship with Search Party to grow. Lastly, **pray** for new partnerships with people in Malta and beyond to expand God’s kingdom in this region.

Pray for B from the Gambia. He is a young M* who has heard the Gospel many times but fears that he might lose friends and family if he commits to Jesus. He has asked that we **pray** for his documents so that he might be able to remain in Italy. Also, **pray** for him as he has not been to school this entire year because of covid-19. He is also asking for **prayer** for his health so he can play football.

Catalina is filled with migrants waiting for their court hearings. Many have been there for years and out of desperation they often start peddling drugs or become part of the sex industry. As you walk through these streets, **pray** for their hope to be restored in Jesus and for the Italian churches to respond with mercy to these ones.
